Sub: Approved Vacancies of JE-DMS-CMA (pay level-6) for notification in 2025

Ref. Railway Board' Letter No. 2024/E (RRB)/25/38 dated 10.10.2024

Assessment of vacancies of **JE-DMS-CMA** categories done by Zonal Railways/PUs in the Indent Management module of HRMS has been examined in Railway Board.

2. The Competent (CRB & CEO) authority has approved to issue Centralized Employment Notification (CEN) for **2570** vacancies in **35** categories of Junior Engineers, Depot Material Superintendent (DMS) and Chemical and Metallurgical Assistant (CMA), all in pay level-6, for the year 2025 as given below:



3. The Railway/PU-wise distribution of vacancies is given in **Annexure – A**. Immediate action should be taken by Zonal Railways/PUs for placing the final indent (not exceeding vacancies approved by Board) in OIRMS within a period of one week in consultation with Chairman/RRB/Bengaluru. While placing final indent, Railways/Pus must ensure prescribed reservation norms for SC/ST/OBC/EWS etc.
4. The list of categories with identical post parameters (medical standards, PwBD attributes and educational / technical qualification) is given in **Annexure-B**. Vacancies of these categories will be clubbed for recruitment purpose. Nodal RRB may explore further scope to consolidate the vacancies based on the current post parameters and issue the Centralized Employment

Notification in the clubbed categories. There should be a clear mention in the CEN about the different departments where vacancies of similar posts have been clubbed so that the candidates are aware of the departments to which they may be posted. The CEN will also specifically include a provision that final allotment of department and category will be done by the concerned Railways and PUs, based on their requirement. After the CEN is issued, concerned RRBs will inform details of categories being clubbed alongwith vacancies actually notified to the respective PCPOs.

5. After recruitment process is over, RRBs will send panels to Railways/PUs in clubbed categories without mentioning the department. Railways/PUs in turn will assign the selected candidates to the original categories based on the vacancies available and community wise distribution. This will provide the required flexibility to the field units based on the real-time vacancies.
